COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Election Commission to designate a staff-person within their office to make regular daily trips to the Post Office in order to pick up absentee ballots to ensure that all ballots properly mailed are returned in a timely fashion before 8:00 a.m. on Election Day; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Election Commission to establish a system whereby the designated person who picks up the absentee ballots makes a daily record as to the number of ballots received, the time that they were received and from whom, so that these may be cross-referenced with the application cards requesting said ballots.
