The undersigned respectfully pray that the undersigned
owners of real estate and abutting on the street in
Mass 4, marked on the Map as Valentine Street,
respectfully ask for information, by whose authority
the sign has been taken down and carried
away. A short time since, a sign was put up on
said street by the Superintendent, with the words
Valentine Street thereon, and has been taken
down. Our conveyances are described in lots as
"Valentine St," and if that name is to be discontinued
great troubles and litigation may arise from
it. We therefore respectfully request that measures
may be taken to ascertain who removed said sign,
and that the street may be called Valentine
street hereafter by the authority of the City of
Cambridge.
