The City of Cambridge Public Works Department will repave Broadway starting Monday, September 10, 1973. The paving is scheduled to be completed in five days, weather permitting. The paving will be done in a series of four steps so as not to inconvenience the residents of the area and to insure the least amount of detours. The times and dates of the scheduled paving is as follows:

Monday, September 10, 1973 - 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

Broadway from Portland St. to Columbia St.

Tuesday, September 11, 1973 - 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Broadway from Columbia St. to Prospect St.

Wednesday, September 12, 1973 - 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 PM.

Broadway from Prospect St. to Highland Ave.

Thursday, September 13, 1973 - 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

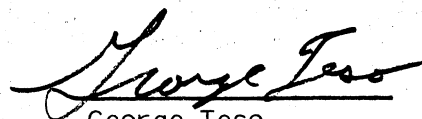
Broadway from Highland Ave. to Felton St.

Friday, September 14, 1973 will be used for small repairs or if one of the other days is cancelled, due to inclement weather.

The City of Cambridge requests that during this period that residents be aware of signs and brochures warning them that the City is paving, as any vehicle that is in the area will be towed. The City also asks the residents, businessmen and parkers in the area to please cooperate as any delay in this project will only inconvenience the public for a longer time.
