William P. Elbery was a member of the faculty of Cambridge High and Latin School for forty-three years prior to his retirement in 1967, and

William P. Elbery was not only an outstanding teacher but also distinguished himself in the athletic field having served as Coach of the High and Latin football team for a period of two years and was a pioneer in the establishment of the Driver-Education program for Cambridge High and Latin School which served as a model for all the towns and cities of the entire Commonwealth, therefore be it
