WHEREAS:

One of the two suspects came out of the hotel and began to run as the taxi drivers ran close behind catching up to the suspect and holding him until the police arrived, and

WHEREAS:

By virtue of this quick action the police were able to arrest a second suspect who remained inside the hotel thereby bringing to a quick resolve the seven thousand dollar gold jewelry robbery which had taken place only minutes earlier, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record extending our congratulations to David Ferreira, Hyatt Regency Doorman, George Sawin and William Safranski for their quick and able observation and assistance at the robbery, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to each of the above individuals on behalf of the entire City Council.
