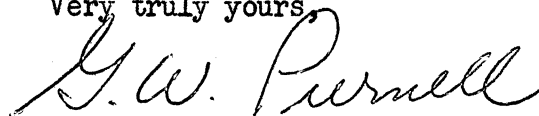
Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 28, Regulation of Traffic, Article III, Section 4, Location of Bus Stops, trackless trolley stops, taxicab stands and service zones, the Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby granted permission to temporarily relocate the bus stop at the rear of 1010 Memorial Drive, Cambridge located on Mt. Auburn Street adjacent to the Mt. Auburn Hospital, at the former Stillman Infirmary, a distance of eighty feet towards the general direction of Watertown, north of the existing driveway.
