Ladies and Gentlemen:

On a number of occasions since the inception of our plans to establish a Colonel Sanders' store on the corner of Hampshire and Prospect Streets, I have offered the opportunity to interested parties--private or governmental--to advise me in the design and execution of our proposed new store.

My company philosophy and business principles at all times require the exertion of every effort to develop favorable relationships with the communities and cities in which we do business. Further, the construction of a new store should be undertaken with a view towards substantially enhancing the property we occupy and the neighborhoods in which we locate.

This letter is intended to emphasize that these offers were not meant to be undertaken as a negotiating posture, but legitimately represented intentions of good will. The favorable outcome of the court issue does not in any way change our position. We expect to undertake the construction of our new store at the earliest possible opportunity; and once again, we invite any and all interested parties--particularly the Planning Board, who have had stated concerns, and the Model Cities Board, who have shown a constructive interest--to meet with me for the purpose of reviewing what it is we intend to do, and to provide me with thoughts or ideas that will have a positive effect on our development. With practical limitations of course, we are interested in doing the best possible job that can be done, including without limitation the following: a newly-designed building, extensive landscaping, and attractive fencing and lighting.

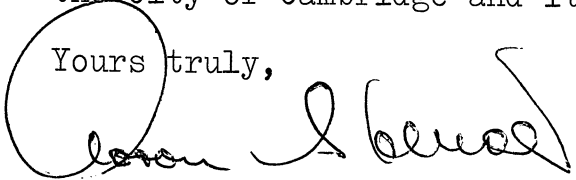
Because time is of the essence, the long delay having been enormously costly in real and implied dollars, I would hope that those parties willing to assist in our project would contact me within the next several weeks.
