To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant for \$34,000.00 from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Human Rights Grant Fund Other Ordinary Maintenance account to provide funds to hire a fair housing case coordinator. This person will work closely with the executive director, processing cases and conducting outreach in the communities of Cambridge. Additionally, the funding contract requires that CHRC purchase an additional computer in order to interface with HUD's Complaint Monitoring and Reporting System in Washington, D. C. Finally, the grant provides a significant amount of money for commissioner training; it will enable us to participate in the regional HUD training as well as the national training course that is offered on a yearly basis.

Passage of this order is recommended.
