- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Cambridge Police Lieutenant Timothy J. Toomey will retire from active duty effective November 30, 1984, completing twenty-six years of service to the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Tim was appointed a permanent Patrol Officer on May 19, 1958, having worked for several years as a Machinist at Scully Signal Company, and having served his country during World War II as a member of the U.S. Army Air Corps; and
- WHEREAS: Officer Toomey served in several patrol assignments, and on July 1, 1975, having successfully completed a promotional examination, was promoted to the rank of Sergeant, serving in the Detective Bureau for many years prior to his once again successfully completing a promotional examination to the rank of Lieutenant, a position he was appointed to on January 10, 1983; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Toomey has most recently served as Administrative Assistant to Police Chief Anthony Paolillo, a position which requires a high degree of sensitivity, intelligence, leadership and responsibility, characteristics which Tim has possessed throughout his law enforcement career; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Toomey, who served as a role model for so many officers, will be greatly missed by his friends and colleagues, because of his understanding, compassion and honesty; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes to Lieutenant Timothy J. Toomey as he enters a new phase of his life and to further extend to both him and his wife Eileen every good wish for much health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Toomey on behalf of the entire City Council.
