- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Food Pantry Network/CEOC, which currently feeds more than one thousand families each month, has announced that it will hold a citywide "Feed the Children" Food Drive on May 6-13, 1990 to feed the growing number of hungry residents in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: More than two thousand pregnant women, mothers, babies and young children are kept on waiting lists for special food programs and more than three thousand children in Cambridge suffer from inadequate nutrition; and
- WHEREAS: This food drive will begin on May 6, 1990, the date for the annual Project Bread Walk for Hunger; now be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council shall proclaim May 6, 1990 "Walk for Hunger" Day in Cambridge urging the full support of all of Cambridge's residents to support the hungry and ensure the success of this and other food drives; be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Cambridge Food Pantry Network and to Project Bread.
