VICE MAYOR REEVES

- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the appropriate City Department to immediately determine if the storage container located across from 85 Bishop Allen Drive is to be used within the next 2 weeks; and be it further
- ORDERED: If not, direct the relevant City Department to remove said storage container as it presents a hazard to public safety; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the location of the storage container at the said site is presently attracting debris causing traffic congestion, presents a blind spot for children crossing Bishop Allen Drive and reduces the available parking spaces in the Bishop Allen Drive area; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the public parking spaces in the area are needed for employees and invitees to the community, institutions, businesses and residents of the Bishop Allen Drive Area; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back on the removal of said storage container within 2 weeks time.
