COUNCILLOR CLEM

WHEREAS: H 5578, URBAN PARK AND RECREATION FUND, would establish a separate fund for urban park and recreation land acquisition and provide for 80% state matching of the project cost; and

WHEREAS: This bill is of tremendous help to urban areas which are now at a competitive disadvantage with suburban areas in that funds have been geared towards conservation acquisition, which is impractical in densely populated cities; and

WHEREAS: By increasing the state match from 50% to 80%, H 5578 makes active recreation acquisition easier for our cities, which are particularly hard pressed by rising costs; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council strongly endorses H 5578 and urges our State delegation to work for the passage of this important legislation.
