To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a donation from Harvard University for \$50,000 to the Grant Fund Human Services Salaries and Wages account (\$5,000) and Other Ordinary Maintenance (\$45,000) account to support youth employment services for Cambridge Teens.

The Office of Workforce Development, in collaboration with two youth employment agencies (Just-A-Start's Teen Works Program and the Work Force Program of the Cambridge Housing Authority) will use the funds to support school year placements for teens with employment barriers. In addition, funds will be used to support the development of an after-school program to build business skills and introduce young adults to the world of entrepreneurship as well as to support an intensive Job Readiness and Career Development Program to serve CRLS students to better prepare them for private sector employment.
