That a public hearing be held at 6:30 PM, April 26 at the regular meeting of the City Council on the subject of conversion of streetlights to sodium vapor, and in connection therewith the Public Works is requested to provide a plan showing the location of existing and proposed sodium vapor lights and a breakdown for each of the possible forms of streetlights, by original cost, maintenance cost, electrical costs, and lumen output; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the Assistant to the City Council is requested to notify all neighborhood organizations, community councils, the Historic Commission, the Traffic Department, the Community Development Department, the Public Works Department, the Electrical Department, and the Plant and Garden Club, and the Cambridge Electric Light Company.

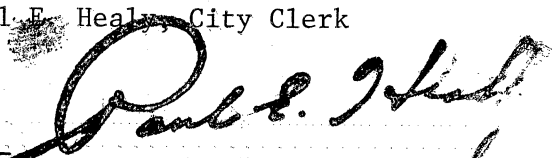
