Does that mean that those fleeing Marxist
regimes will not receive sanctuary?

The law on political sanctuary applies
only to those who are singled out as individuals
for punishment by their government.
It does not include those who claim they
might possibly be punished. Under your
interpretation, whole countries could migrate to
the U.S. because there may be potential
danger.
