in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.

An Ordinance,

in addition to "An Ordinance, providing for the appointment, and prescribing the duties, of City Marshal, and establishing a City Watch."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

1. So much of "An Ordinance, providing for the appointment, and prescribing the duties, of City Marshal, and establishing a City Watch," passed on the thirtieth day of June eighteen hundred and forty-six, as relates to the appointment and duties of City Marshal and two Deputy Marshals, is hereby repealed.

2. The Mayor and Aldermen shall forthwith appoint, and shall hereafter, at the commencement of every municipal year, appoint, three principal constables, one of whom shall reside in Ward One, one in Ward Two, and one in Ward Three, who shall, within their respective Wards, perform all the duties heretofore required to be performed by the City and Deputy Marshals.

3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
