CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Six.

AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

SECTION 1: The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge are hereby amended by establishing Chapter 2, Article 2A, entitled Department of Administration.

SECTION 2: Be it ordained, for the purpose of aiding in the general supervision and coordination of the City Departments and to aid and assist the City Manager in the proper performance of his office that this Department is to be known as the Department of Administration. The Department of Administration shall be under the control of the Assistant City Manager, who shall be considered a department head within the provisions of General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Chapter 43, Section 103.

SECTION 3: The Assistant City Manager shall be appointed by the City Manager and shall hold office during the pleasure of the City Manager. It is the intention of this provision to fix all responsibility and vest all authority for the appointment and removal of the Assistant City Manager in the City Manager.

SECTION 4: The Assistant City Manager shall have no rights under Civil Service, nor shall the Assistant City Manager acquire any rights of tenure in any manner.

SECTION 5: The powers and duties of the Assistant City Manager shall be such as are designated and assigned from time to time to the Assistant City Manager by the City Manager. The Assistant City Manager shall have all the powers, rights and duties that the City Manager shall determine as are necessary for the proper administration of the departments, commissions, boards and officers, consistent with the powers and duties assigned to him by the City Manager. In the absence or disability of the City Manager the Assistant City Manager shall assume the duties of the City Manager, subject to the formal approval of the City Council.

SECTION 6: The Assistant City Manager shall receive fifteen thousand dollars annually.

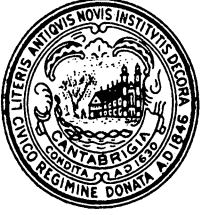


