Dear Mayor and City Council of Cambridge:

What authority grants, what reason dictates, what right is presumed by the mayor and city council of Cambridge to declare the city opposed to the middle east policy of the president and national congress? The city officials were recently elected on the basis of their positions on local issues and were given absolutely no endorsement by city residents to speak for them on national and foreign policy questions. Having a daughter on active duty with the military, I deeply resent the presumptuous sign over Central Square that may convey to her and her comrades an attitude I don't share. The mayor and city council should immediately remove this offense and confirm their deliberations and endorsements to domains for which they were elected.
