754 feet northwesterly,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land Fifty feet
in width between Foxcroft street, and a
point about 754 feet northwesterly,

included between the red lines as shown on a plan drawn by W. A. Mason & Son
Engineers, dated June 28. 1882.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that no damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,
