At the School Committee meeting held on July 12th, it was voted to place on file your communication relative to allowing the playground in the rear of the High School to be used for playground purposes, because at the present time the W.P.A. are working there, putting it in useable condition.

At this same meeting the Chairman presented two additional communications requesting that the school yards of the Abraham Lincoln School and the Agassiz School be used as playgrounds for the children during the summer months, and the School Committee voted to grant this permission provided that the Park Department will supply the necessary supervision.
