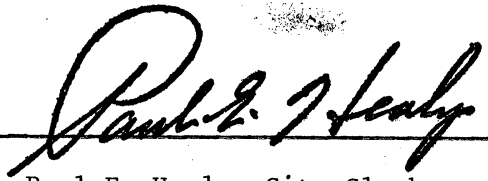

- WHEREAS: Bill served the City with distinction, holding several key positions within City government, including serving as City Engineer, Assessor, and Purchasing Agent; and
- WHEREAS: Bill was always active in local civic affairs and served for awhile as President of the Cambridge Municipal Employees Credit Union and as the President of the Rindge Technical High School Alumni Association, as well as serving as Chairman of the New England Division of the American Water Works Association; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council, in recognition of the many years of service and dedication of William H. McGinnis, hereby names the Pumping Station at the Fresh Pond Reservoir the "William H. McGinnis Pumping Station"; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Superintendent of the Water Department to take the appropriate steps to have a suitable plaque prepared and for a dedication ceremony to be held in the near future.
