IN CITY COUNCIL

February 2, 1981

WHEREAS: -

Implementing the regulations of the Community Development Block Grant Program (Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974) requires annual adoption by the City Council of a resolution to accomplish the following:

1. Direct that a Block Grant application be filed for funding;
2. Direct the City Manager or Assistant City Manager for Community Development acting for the City Manager, to file said application, make amendments as required, and execute related contracts; and
3. Direct that the Federal Government be notified that Cambridge will comply with all Block Grant Program assurances and understandings required by law and administrative regulation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE:

That the fulfillment of the requirements of the foregoing paragraph by the City Manager or the Assistant City Manager for Community Development is authorized hereby and, in addition, specifically that the City Manager or Assistant City Manager for Community Development file an application for Federal Block Grant entitlement funds available to Cambridge in Fiscal Year 1982 as provided by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE:

That said application be filed with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on or before February 25, 1981 for the required 45-day "A-95 Review," and with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before April 15, 1981 for the required 75-day HUD review;

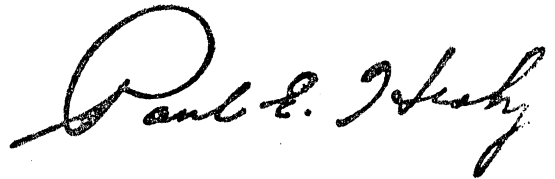
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE:

That the City Manager, or the Assistant City Manager for Community Development acting for the City Manager, is authorized to file such other Block Grant applications under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1977 as he may determine appropriate, including but not limited to applications under the Urban Development Action Grant provisions of said Housing and Community Development Act.

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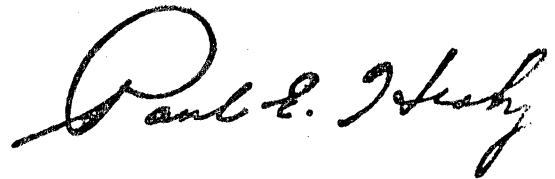
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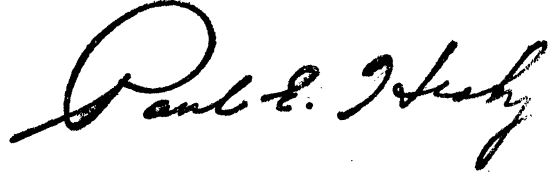
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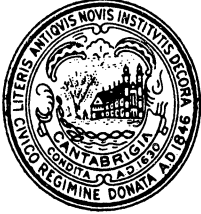

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Transmitted herewith is a proposed resolution authorizing the filing of Block Grant application under the provisions of the U. S. Housing and Development Act of 1974, as amended.

This is essentially the same resolution as adopted by your Honorable Body in each of the first six years of the Federal Block Grant Program with one exception: authorization to file "Urgent Needs" application was changed in 1977 to "Urban Development Action Grant" applications to conform with the new legislation.

We intend to file our Seventh Year "Entitlement" application with HUD by April 15, 1981. HUD is currently estimating that the amount of our Entitlement will be \$3,700,000, which is a decrease of approximately \$200,000 from this year's grant.
