- WHEREAS: This response does not allay the fears of City employees and their dependents; and
- WHEREAS: Regulation 805 CMR 9.23: Leaves of Absence (The Commonwealth of Massachusetts Group Insurance Commission) allows for an employee to continue his or her insurance during military leave of absence on the same terms as active employees; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to re-examine the City's present policy in order to allay the fears of and maintain the full health coverage for City employees if and when they are activated for duty in the Gulf.

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RESOLVED: That parents urge their children of school age to be members of the Cambridge Boys and Girls Club.
