

# City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Seventy Eight.

## An Ordinance establishing the Office of City Physician.

Be it ordained by the City Council of  
the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sect. 1.

In the month of January, in the year  
Eighteen Hundred and Seventy-Eight and every  
third year thereafter, there shall be appointed  
by the Mayor and Aldermen, a City Physician.

He shall enter upon the duties of his office  
upon the first Monday of February next suc-  
ceeding his appointment. He shall receive  
an annual salary of Three Hundred Dollars,  
payable quarterly. He shall be removable  
at the will of the Mayor, with the approval  
of the Board of Aldermen. A vacancy  
shall be immediately filled in like manner  
at any time for the unexpired term.

Sect. 2.

The City Physician, upon notice in  
writing from the Mayor or Chief of Police  
to the Board of Health, shall examine  
into all nuisances, sources of filth

and causes of disease within the City, and inquire into all sources of danger to the public health, and report thereon to the Board.

Sect. 3. He shall supply the Physicians of the City Institutions and Dispensary with vaccine virus at the expense of the City, to be charged to the expenditures of the Board of Health.

Sect. 4. He shall, when requested by the Mayor, Board of Aldermen or Chief of Police, examine all candidates for appointment in the Police force; the condition of all officers absent from duty; all cases of injury whereby the City may become liable; and he shall examine into causes of death of persons dying with no physician in attendance.
