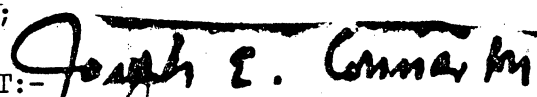

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Ronald Palermo, owner of All & Everything for the purpose of conducting a display of merchandise to be held the sidewalk at 2259 Massachusetts Avenue, commencing immediately and running through the spring, summer and fall seasons, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk at said premises, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.), conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

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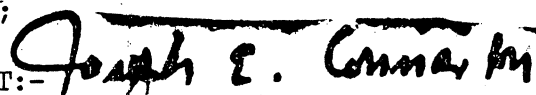

He would like to display antique furniture on his sidewalk at this site on Massachusetts Avenue. He would like to use up to 25% of the sidewalk for this purpose.

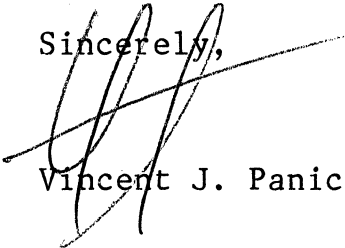
