CONTRACT

Agreement made and entered into 1st day of July, 1974  
by and between the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, by its Council on the Arts and Humanities, party of the  
first part, and Cambridge Public Library, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties, the party of the first part for itself, and the party of the second part for itself,  
its successors and assigns, in consideration of the several promises and agreements each to the other made as  
herein set forth, do hereby severally promise and agree to and with each other as follows:

FIRST, The party of the second part hereby agrees to furnish and deliver to the party of the first part the  
services described on page one of this contract. The party of the second part further agrees to furnish and  
deliver to the party of the first part a written evaluation of the said services.

SECOND, The party of the second part further agrees that all of said services shall be rendered promptly.

THIRD, The party of the second part agrees to comply with the provisions of the "Governor's Code of Fair  
Practices" of January 12, 1966 and Chapter 151B of the Massachusetts General Laws as amended, relating  
to non-discrimination within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, which provisions are herein incorporated  
by reference.

FOURTH, the party of the second part agrees that it will add to the amount  
paid it by the Council for the purposes set forth on page one of this  
contract an equal amount, on a dollar for dollar basis, in a manner  
authorized by and acceptable to the Council on the Arts and Humanities.

FIFTH, the party of the first part agrees to pay the party of the second  
part the sum of \$4,500.00 payable as follows: in five (5) payments re-  
quested between July 1, 1974 and September 15, 1974.



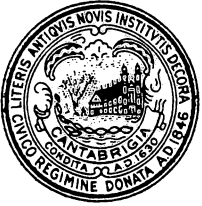
