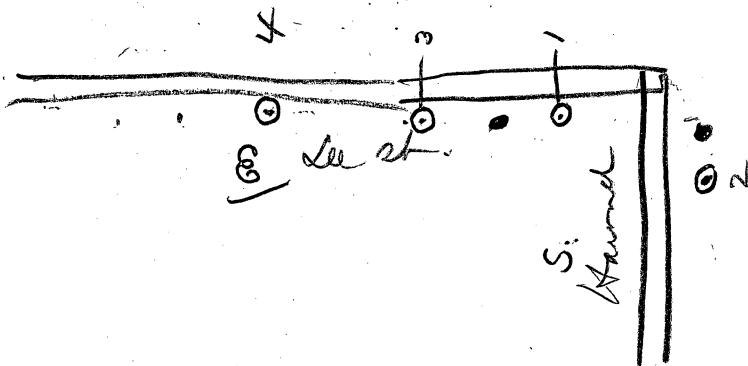

One tree on the east side of Hancock street, being the fifth tree north of Harvard street; it is therefore hereby

ORDERED, That public notice be given, by publication in the Cambridge Press, that this Board will give hearings in reference to the removal of the trees above mentioned on Tuesday, the 10th day of September next, at 8 o'clock P. M., and all persons interested may then appear for or against such removal.
