**Ordered,**

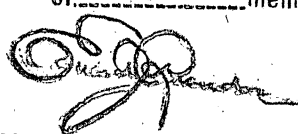

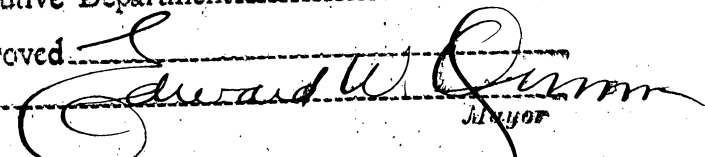
