

We, the undersigned, owners of land on Worcester Street, in the City of Cambridge, in consideration of One Dollar to us paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for other good and valuable considerations, hereby, for ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, severally promise and agree, to and with the City of Cambridge, that neither we, nor any person claiming by, through or under us, shall make any claim for damages, for land taken or to be taken, by the City for the widening of said Worcester Street two feet on the Northwth Side thereof, provided said widening is made during the present year.
