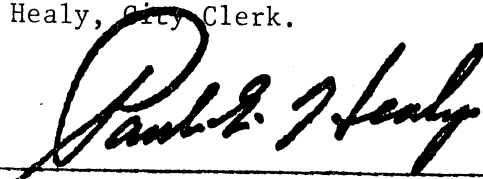

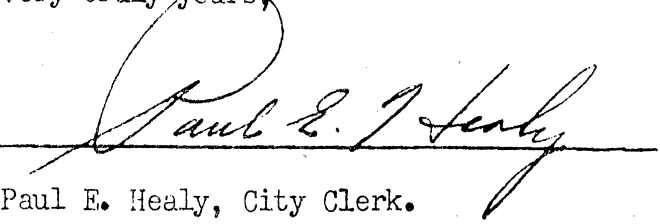
Dear Neighborhood Representative:

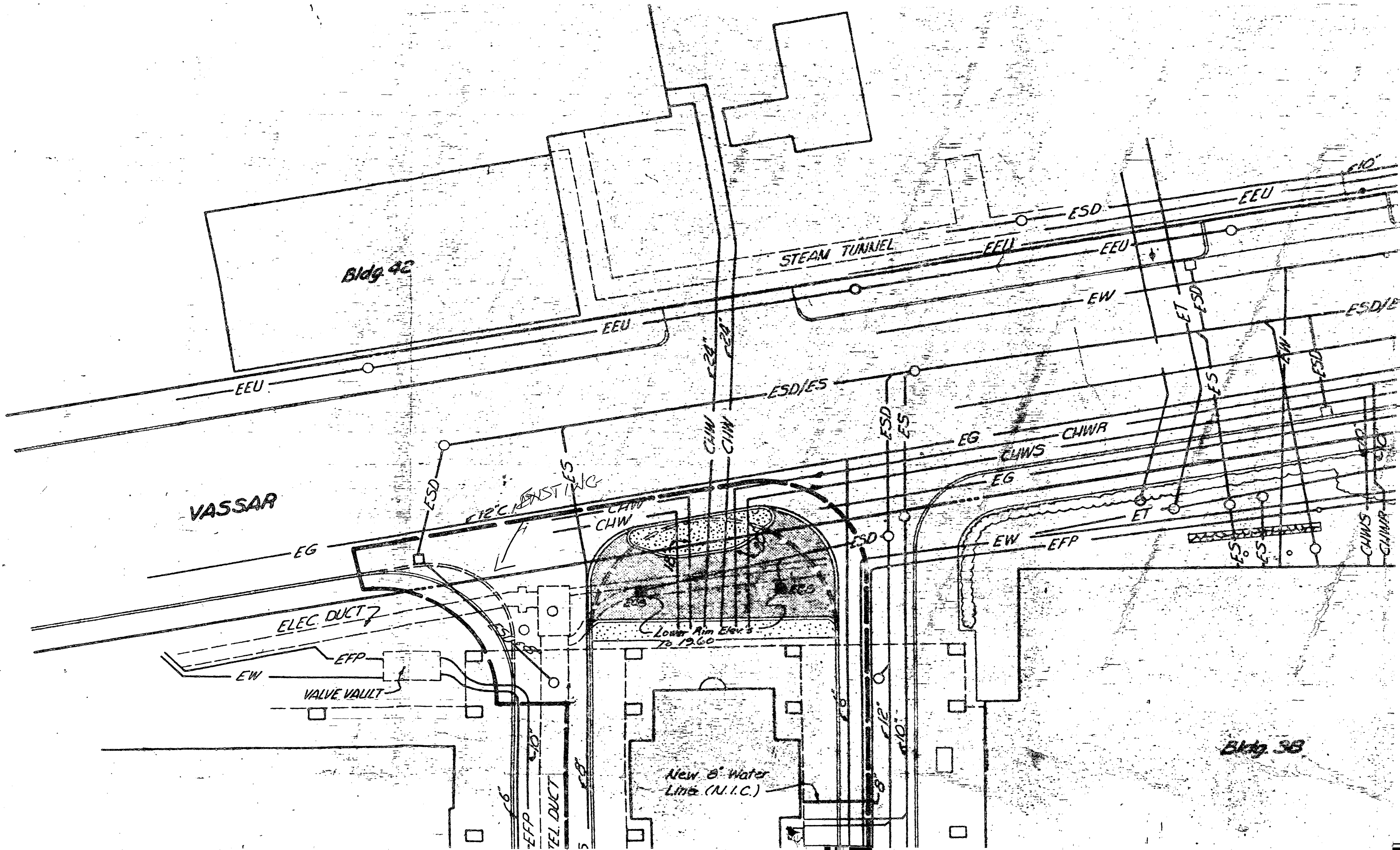

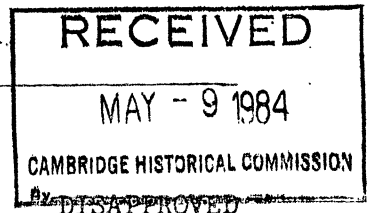
