- WHEREAS: Tony, as he was known to the hundreds of drill team members during his 50 year career, began his involvement with the team during the 1950's when his daughter Dolores joined the team; and
- WHEREAS: Through his long stewardship and the total committment of the drill team members, have long been a presense in the color guard competitions, providing each audience with breath taking performances year after year; and
- WHEREAS: Even though Tony had recently undergone chemotherapy treatment for bladder cancer, he showed up at every practice to encourage the team as well as provide direction and guidance; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Dolores Zappala and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record designating the corner of Florence Street and Pleasant Street as **"ANTHONY ZAPPALA SQUARE"** in memory of this tireless supporter of the color guard and of Blessed Sacrament Church; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk in conjunction with the Commissioner of Public Works prepare a suitable sign and ceremony; and be it further
