ORDERED:

In view of the approaching winter weather, that at the next regular meeting of the City Council the Acting Commissioner of Public Works and a representative of the Community Development Department be available to discuss with the City Council and the City Manager means by which brick sidewalks throughout the City can receive emergency repairs. This Order is prompted by the prevalence of gaps in many sidewalks at spots under which tree roots run, and by the rapid deterioration which occurs once a few bricks are loosened. The City Manager is requested to secure from the appropriate departments, in preparation for the meeting, rough estimates of the number of holes which need to be repaired, the approximate cost and possible means of financing repairs, and techniques, such as replacing bricks, creating borders around roots, temporary filling with asphalt, etc.
