RESOLUTION APPROVING AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A PROPOSED CONTRACT FOR A NEIGHBORHOOD FACILITIES GRANT PROJECT IN THE WALDEN SQUARE AREA UNDER SECTION 703 OF THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1965, AS AMENDED, CONTRACT NO. B-1083 BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS, AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

WHEREAS:

The United States of America (herein called the "Government") has tendered to the City of Cambridge (herein called the "Grantee") a proposed Contract for a Neighborhood Facilities Grant Project under Section 703 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965, as amended, under which the Government would make an advance of Federal funds to the Grantee with respect to the Project designated as Project No. NFP-MA-01-06-1010, in the Walden Square Area as described in such proposed Contract; and

WHEREAS:

The Grantee has given due consideration to said proposed Contract;

BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Section 1.

The proposed Contract for Neighborhood Facilities Grant under Section 703 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965, as amended, designated Contract No. B-1083 consisting of Parts I and II under and subject to the terms and conditions of which the Government would make a grant of Federal funds to the Grantee to aid in financing the cost of the Cambridge Neighborhood Facility in Walden Square Area, designated as Project NFP-MA-01-06-1010, situated in the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, is hereby in all respects approved.

Section 2.

The City Manager of the Grantee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said proposed Contract in two counterparts on behalf of the Grantee, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to impress and attest the official seal of the Grantee on each such counterpart and to forward such counterparts to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for execution on behalf of the Government, together with other documents relative to the approval and execution thereof as well as to this Resolution as may be required by the Government.

Resolution - Walden Square Area (cont.)

Section 3.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to file requisition, together with necessary supporting documents, with the Government, from time to time as grant funds are required, requesting payments to be made on account of the grant provided for in said Contract, and to do and perform all other things and acts required to be done or performed in order to obtain such payments.

Section 4.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
