Dear Mr. Sullivan:

I am writing you to report on progress of work at the Fresh Pond Reservation which was funded by a 1978 Block Grant and matching funds raised by the Cambridge Plant and Garden Club.

Last year, working with the City, the Club planned and planted a 400 foot screen of trees and shrubs along the Fresh Pond Parkway at the northeast corner of the Reservation. The plant material cost approximately \$2,200. This year we plan to continue planting to the west, along the pond. We are working with full cooperation from Conrad Fagone, Department of Public Works, and the Cambridge Water Board. This will use up the remaining funds.

Next year we hope to secure funding for work to the west of Black's Nook. We have already won \$1,500 from a national competition of the Garden Club of America for this.

I am enclosing a list of this year's plant material.

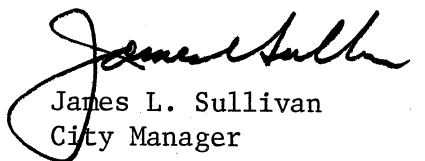
