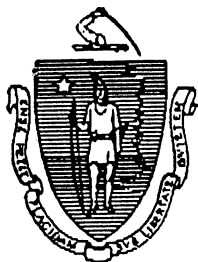

COMMONWEALTH GAS COMPANY

Petition of Commonwealth Gas Company requesting that an exception to 220 CMR 101.06(11) be granted pursuant to 220 CMR 101.02 to permit installation and operation of approximately 4000 feet of 12 inch gas main at an operating pressure of 329 psig (pounds per square inch). The line will be installed from the Commonwealth Gas/Algonquin Gas, Third Street, Cambridge Gate Station to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology proposed power plant via Third Street, Broadway, Sixth Street, Main Street, and Albany Street, Cambridge.

D.P.U. 93-199 is OFFICIALLY CAPTIONED:

Petition of Commonwealth Gas Company to the Department requesting that an exception be granted to the pertinent provisions of paragraph 6 of Section 1 of the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities Order 11725-H (220 CMR 101.06(11)) to permit the installation and operation of approximately 4000 feet of 12 inch gas main to be operated at 329 psig.

Upon the foregoing petition, the Department of Utilities will conduct a public hearing in the Ackermann Room, Cambridge City Hall, 795 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts on Tuesday, February 22, 1994 at 7:30 P.M.

The petitioner, Commonwealth Gas Company, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication once hereof fourteen (14) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, the Boston Herald and the Cambridge Chronicle; to serve a copy hereof by certified mail at least fourteen (14) days prior to such hearing on the City Clerk, the Mayor and the Chairman of Planning Board of Cambridge; and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
