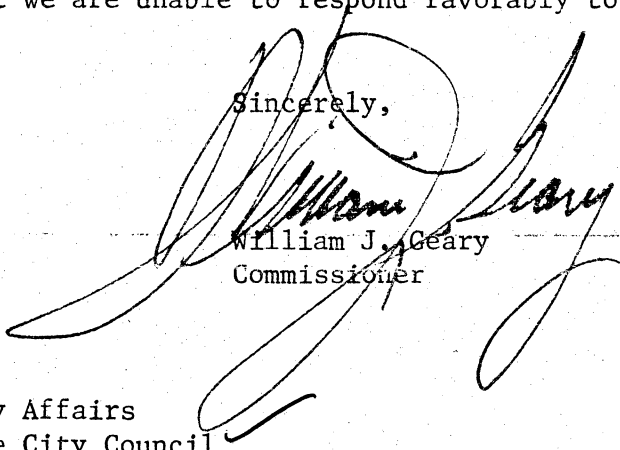
Dear Mr. Cusick:
