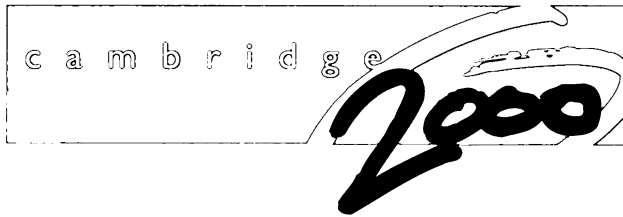

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$380,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Community Development Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Massachusetts Highway Department and the Federal Highway Association, through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program administered by Caravan for Commuters, Inc., have awarded funds to develop and implement a shuttle to connect portions of Cambridge to North Station. The grant will provide the majority of funding needed for the first year of service for a shuttle connecting North Station with Kendall Square and University Park, as well as intermediate points. The matching funds required for this grant will be provided by the participating private companies in the area. As per the grant agreement, the service will be open to the general public. This project is being undertaken in cooperation with the Charles River Transportation Management Association, which will manage day-to-day operation of the service.
