*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:*

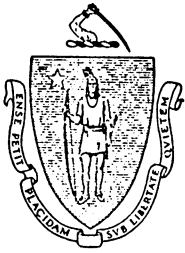
SECTION 1. Any publicly owned ambulances of the City of Cambridge and operated by its fire department in the rendition of emergency medical and ambulance services is hereby exempt from the application of the provisions of Chapter 111C of the General Laws for a period of one and one-half years from the date of passage of this Act.

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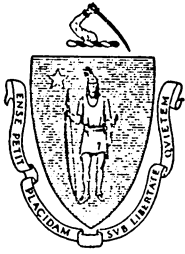
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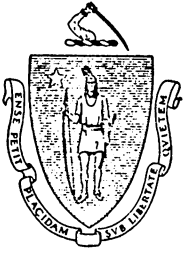

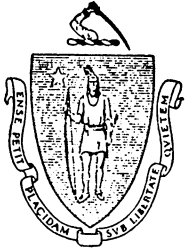
