WHEREAS: William was also track and field coach at Malden Catholic High School from 1954 to 1960 and coach of the Rindge Tech track team from 1960 to 1966; and

WHEREAS: William was president of the Metropolitan Cross Country League from 1957 to 1965 and a member of the Board of Directors of the Massachusetts Track and Field Officials Association from 1973 to 1977; and

WHEREAS: William's passing will leave a void in the lives of all of his surviving family, his wife Emilia; his children William, Jr., Robert H. Francis X, and Mary P. Lovell; his sisters Mary Cullinane and Louise Sagalini; his ten grandchildren and two great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS: William will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
