\$7,600,000.00	Construction or reconstruction of sewers, sewerage systems and surface drains;
\$4,000,000.00	Remodeling, reconstruction and making extraordinary repairs to the Morse, Agassiz and Haggerty Schools; and
\$100,000.00	Purchase of works of art for public buildings and other public areas; and be it further

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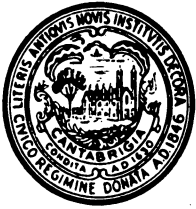

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the amendment of the loan order passed on May 6, 1991 to increase the amount allocated for the construction of the Area Four Teen Center from \$1,030,000 to \$1,930,000 which, when combined with \$1,000,000 in previously appropriated funds, will bring the total amount available for the project to \$2,930,000. This additional appropriation is necessitated by the decision to add 3,500 square feet of additional ground floor space to be set aside primarily for a day care program. The additional \$900,000 will provide the funds needed to fully equip and furnish, as well as construct, the day care center. Additionally, funds are also provided for landscaping, parking, architectural and engineering costs, and a contingency.
