Please be advised at the meeting of the City Council dated April 28, 1986 discussion centered around the above referenced communication from Helen A. Young, et al as it relates to the issue of sidewalk construction in and around the Pearl Street area. Both Councillors David Sullivan and Francis Duehay requested that you confer with the petitioner in an effort to determine whether bricks or concrete is more desirable for the neighborhood.
