An Ordinance

Establishing the Salary of the Mayor of the City.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge
as follows:

Sect. I. So much of the Ordinance establishing the Salaries of Sundry City Officers, adopted December 24th, in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-six, as relates to the Salary of the Mayor, is hereby repealed.

Sect. II. From and after the first Monday in January, in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Eight, the Salary of the Mayor of the City shall be Fifteen Hundred Dollars annually, payable in equal quarterly Payments; which shall be in full for all services rendered by him in his official Capacity.
