ORDERED: That the City Manager confer with the Commissioner of the Police Department, with a view in mind of determining why our law officials are not stopping this company and others for not complying with the laws of the City; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to inquire of the City Solicitor and request back to the City Council as to whether the provisions in the Noise Ordinance relative to vibrations cover the disturbance created by truck start-up and movement noises in the case of Portland Stoneware and similar situations, and if it is determined that the present language does not prohibit these activities, then the report back shall contain proposed amendments to accomplish this purpose.
