

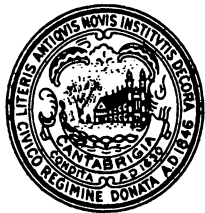

Enclosed are three orders relative to the acceptance and appropriation of grants totalling \$17,000 to the Other Ordinary Maintenance account of the Community Development Department. One grant (\$8,000) from the Metropolitan Area Planning Council will be used to conduct a study of on-street parking in Cambridge. The second grant (\$9,000) is a Title III grant to the Somerville-Cambridge Home Care Corporation to be used to hire a coordinator to work with nursing home administrators.
