COUNCILLOR D. SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: The cost of energy has been escalating at rates far beyond the general rate of inflation; and
- WHEREAS: Residents of Massachusetts are particularly hard pressed to meet energy bills due to our harsh climate and in older housing stock; and
- WHEREAS: The proposed Federal Fuel Assistance Program will leave many Massachusetts residents, especially the elderly and smaller families, extremely vulnerable and ineligible for assistance; and
- WHEREAS: All indications are that the General Court of the Commonwealth will prorogue this year without making provisions for a state fuel assistance program to serve these citizens of the Commonwealth; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council urges Governor Edward J. King, and the members of the General Court to make a state fuel assistance program part of the state budget and that this be done before the legislative prorogues this session; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Council instructs the City Clerk to transmit copies of this resolution to His Excellency, Governor Edward J. King, Senate President William Bulger, Senator Michael LoPresti, Senator Chester Atkins, Chairman Senate Ways and Means Committee, Representative Charles Flaherty, Representative Saundra Graham, Representative Michael Lombardi, and Representative John Finnegan, Chairman, House Ways and Means Committee.
