Dear City Council Members:

The members of the Santa Lucia Society of 136 Cushing Street, Cambridge together with the residents of the Strawberry Hill Section of Cambridge are very disturbed and upset by the rash of breaking and entering in homes the past several weeks. There have been at least sixteen (16) break-ins and people are scared stiff. These break-ins have been committed as early as 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the evening and as late as 3:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. in the early morning.

Whatever has become of the proposed addition of thirty (30) foot patrolmen to the police force?

The presence of foot patrolmen visibility would greatly increase the safety of our residents, and also would alleviate the fear and restore peace of mind to our residents.

We urge very strongly that the proposed foot patrolmen be implemented to the police force as quickly as possible.
