RULES AND REGULATIONS

"Sec. 2-D. Upon receipt by the Division of an application for a Permit to post, erect or maintain a billboard, sign or other advertising device under this section, notice thereof and a copy of the application will be sent by the Division to the city or town where such billboard, sign or other advertising device is to be located. If the city or town objects to the location it shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of said notice, file with the Division its objections, in writing, and thereupon the Division will notify the applicant, who will be allowed ten (10) days from the date of such notice to file reasons, if any, why a Permit should be granted. A hearing may be given by the Division before final action is taken upon such application."

Please notify the Division whether you approve or disapprove of the application, using given number to identify application.

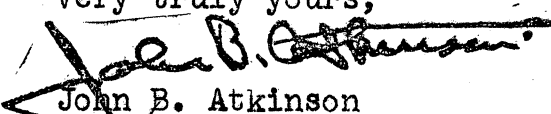
