WHEREAS:-

The amount and method of determining the proportion of the cost of sewers which may be assessed upon abutters as provided by Chapter 83 - Section 14 to 28 of the General Laws, and the standard rate of such assessments having been fixed by Sections 6 and 7 - Chapter 23 of the Revised Ordinances in the year 1892 and

WHEREAS:-

At the present time the assessments as levied under the standard established in 1892 are less than one-fifth of the amount specified in the General Laws, it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the City Engineer be and hereby is directed to submit to the City Council forthwith an estimate of the average cost per running foot of the system of sewers constructed during the past two years in order to determine a standard rate which shall be assessed according to law.
