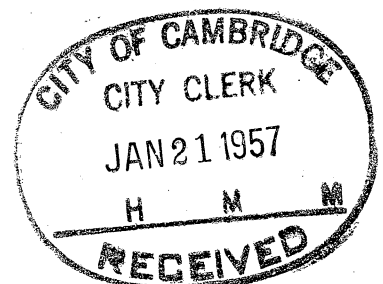
Gentlemen:
