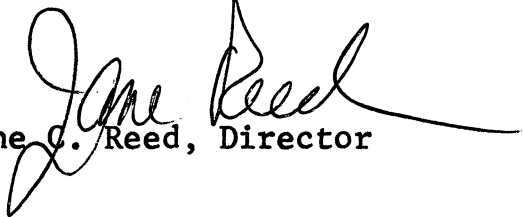
If I understand correctly, we will need permits approved by the City Council for some of these activities. This is a request for these permits.
